Create reports to analyze your field team's planned vs. actual visit, time and mileage details with their deviations.

Types of Routes

There are 2 types of Route Reports for RouteIQ:

- 1. Basic Route Reports
- 2. Advanced Route Reports

Basic Route Reports

With basic route reports you will be able to create reports with a route planned details only and not the actual details. The planned route details are available in the RIQ Routes module.

(i) Feature Availability: Available in the Standard Plan

For example: You could analyze the planned travel distance (Mileage Tracking) but to compare it with the actual traveled distance and the deviation, you would need the Professional plan.

Advanced Route Reports

With advanced route reports you will be able to create reports with a route's planned, actual and deviation details. The route details are available in the RIQ Routes module.

③ Feature Availability: Available in the Professional Plan

For example: You could create reports to analyze how many stops where planned to visit and compare it with the completed visits.



Here is a list of field in the RIQ Routes module using which you can create reports.



Creating Route Reports


1. Open the Reports module in Zoho CRM




2. Click Create Report.




3. Select RIQ Routes as your primary module.



4. Click on rename option




- a. Rename the report
- b. Add a description
- c. Add it to a folder
- d. Click Done
- 1. Click Continue




The report configuration page will open; here you can add the required columns, apply date and advanced filters, etc.

- 6. Add the necessary columns.
 - a. You can group rows based on fields like Route Status, Owner, etc.
 - b. You can aggregate numerical columns based on fields like planned visits, travel distance (Mileage Details), etc.



- 7. Click Filters and apply the necessary filters
 - a. You can add date filters based fields like Planned or Actual Start Time
 - b. You can add advanced filter criteria based on fields like Route Status, Owner, etc.



8. Click Run to have a view of the report and save if you save it for future use.



9. Now the report will be viewed with all the configurations applied.
